**National Archives Bill of Rights 225<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Exhibit  
Available through Humanities Council**

Charleston, WV — The Humanities Council is partnering with the Federation of State Humanities Councils to provide a free, four-sided, pop-up exhibit observing the 225<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Bill of Rights for up to 30 venues in West Virginia. The exhibit kiosk, produced by the National Archives, is 66 ½ inches high by 32 inches wide with a corner to opposite corner measurement of 45 inches. The National Archives will ship the exhibit directly to venues at no cost by mid-November. It does not need to be returned.

Libraries, small museums, community centers, schools, and other organizations that would like to have the exhibit on display during the 225<sup>th</sup> anniversary date of December 15, 2016 must complete and submit a request form to the Humanities Council no later than October 12.
