

## WEST VIRGINIA HUMANITIES COUNCIL GRANT AWARDS ANNOUNCED

Charleston —The West Virginia Humanities Council, the state affiliate of the National Endowment for the Humanities, announced major grant awards approved at its October board meeting. The Humanities Council serves West Virginia through grants and direct programs in the humanities, and budgets more than \$600,000 for grants and programs each year. A variety of grants are offered to nonprofit organizations that support educational programming. Humanities Council major grants are awarded twice annually for projects requesting over \$1,500 and up to \$20,000. **The next major grant deadline is February 1, 2016.**
