4. **Events.** If your project has been associated with a public event during this period (public presentation, etc.), please describe that event. Include location, date, and audience numbers.
5. **Future plans.** Describe any future plans or anticipated activities arising from the project.
6. **Additional information.** Please include any other comments/information related to the project. Include awards and other recognition in this section.
7. **Attachments.** Attach copies (or include URLs) of any news articles, public social media postings, etc. about the project.
8. **Products.** Submit two copies of any products resulting from the fellowship. If the product is not complete at the time of this report, please indicate the estimated date of completion, and submit the products at that time.
