Charleston, WV — Three Charleston historic houses will welcome visitors in honor of West Virginia's birthday on Monday, June 20. The Craik-Patton House, MacFarland-Hubbard House, and Glenwood Estate are offering special hours on West Virginia Day. The open houses are free, and the public is invited.

The Craik-Patton House, built in 1834 and located at 2809 Kanawha Boulevard East, is open from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on June 20; Glenwood Estate, built in 1852 and located at 800 Orchard Street on Charleston's West Side, is open from 10:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. Humanities Council *History Alive!* presenter Gene Worthington will perform as Theodore Roosevelt at 1:00 p.m. at Glenwood. The MacFarland-Hubbard House, headquarters of the West Virginia Humanities Council, is open from 2:00 to 4:00 p.m. and is located at 1310 Kanawha Boulevard East.
